Pacific CURRENTS

Chile's climate is highly influenced by the cooling effect of the Pacific Ocean and the Humboldt Current that begins in the icy waters near Antarctica and flows up the western coast of South America.

Andes

The cool sea air is partially blocked by the Coastal Mountains, although it finds its way inland by following the course of the transversal river valleys.

During the day, sea breezes carried by the cold Humboldt Current penetrate inland, and each night, cold air descends from the snow covered peaks of the Andes.

Chile has much greater diversity in soils and climates from east to west than from north to south.






Ideal WINEGROWING

Natural BARRIERS

Chile's geographic barriers—the Atacama Desert to the north, the Andes Mountains to the east, the Patagonian ice fields to the south, and the Pacific Ocean to the west—make Chile a veritable agricultural island. Together they help maintain healthy conditions and protect vineyards against pests and disease. And with a geography as diverse as Chile's, you can be sure that the climate will have terrific variation.

From 300 kilometers south of Santiago, we can find the beautiful Maule Valley, which has a sub-moist Mediterranean climate with warm summer, which is cooled by breezes of the Pacific Ocean and the Andes Mountains. This cooling influence creates a long growing season with slow ripening of the grapes which enhances the flavours, intensity and concentration of our wines.

Average rainfall in the valley is 730mm and only comes during the winter. This lack of rain helps the viticulturists to control the berry size, as well as to work with a non-interventionist, sustainable approach to viticulture.


MAULE

Valle Frio has 300 hectares of vineyards in the Maule Valley, located on five properties along the region.

20 YEARS Most vineyards are about 20 years old, so the vines have a balanced canopy-grapes development and, with the proper handling, their produce high quality wines.

Differences in the soils textures (clay, sand, stony) gives to each selected vineyard the optimum conditions to express the highest quality of the grapes and finally the terroir expression.


The cellar has four main areas: fermentation of white wines, red wines fermentation, barrel and bottle aging room. The total capacity is over *5 million liters* in mainly stainless steel tanks and *45,000 liters* of French and American oak barrels.



Deep in the heart of Chile's fertile winegrowing plains, well to the south of bustling Santiago, lies the Maule Valley. Flanked on the west by southern Pacific breezes and on the east by the looming Andes, the Maule is often cloudy and cool — a South American reflection of conditions found in Bordeaux or the Rhone. Soils here transition from *tuffeau* (limestone-like, but with better drainage) to volcanic, holding on to only as much of the heavy seasonal rains as needed, and letting the rest run through. Cabernet sauvignon, the keystone grape in this robust blend, finds these conditions much to its liking, producing fruit of magnanimous character and complexity. With a thriving winegrowing infrastructure, excellent terroir and the perfect climate to make great wines, Chile's star is on the rise.

VINTNER'S NOTES: Red fruits, violet and cassis, even tobacco. A lively wine, complex and original. 70% cabernet sauvignon, 15% merlot, 10% malbec, 5% syrah. 1,200 cases made.


